

CAD DRAFTING

Location:

FCAVC, Kendallville, IN

Course Description:

Classroom and lab experiences in the CAD Drafting program are organized to prepare students for college or employment in the broad area of the drafting industry. Instruction covers CAD Drafting, Architectural Drafting, Industrial Mechanical Drafting, Graphic Design and Civil Drafting. The curriculum also includes 3D modeling technology and multiple versions of CAD software. Currently the CAD program utilizes AutoCAD 2007, Inventor, ProE and Architectural Desktop to complete the competencies in either mechanical or architectural drafting.

Program Duration:

This program is open to juniors and seniors who may enroll for one or both years.

Credits:

Students enrolled in CAD Drafting receive credit based upon the type of schedule offered at each school. Students may earn up to 12 hours of dual credit through Ivy Tech Community College and up to 3 credits at Vincennes University.
