

COSMETOLOGY

Location:

FCAVC, Kendallville, IN

Course Description:

Students enrolled in this program receive 1,500 hours of training during the two-year program in areas such as hair cutting, coloring, perming, facials, facial makeup, bacteriology, nails and nail disorders, chemistry, personal grooming, and many more areas. Training follows the state-mandated curriculum with the goal of students earning their cosmetology license upon successful completion of the State Board exam.

Program Duration:

Students will attend vocational cosmetology from approximately August 1, 2008 through early June 2009 with scheduled school calendar vacations and breaks. There will be four hours of daily instruction for students throughout the school year with scheduled Saturday hours periodically throughout the school year.

Credits:

Students enrolled in Cosmetology receive credit based upon the type of schedule offered at each school. Students may earn up to 12 hours of dual credit through Ivy Tech Community College.

Enrollment Procedure:

Students need to contact their Guidance Counselor for an application. Enrollment for the first year students is through an application process conducted by the Cosmetology Instructors and Four County Directors.

Fees:

Students will be responsible for a one-time fee to purchase individual students kits, a smock, and VICA dues. Full payment is due no later than the first day of class in August.
